The Forêt Montmorency

A close encounter with Quebec's boreal forest

With an area of more than 400 km², the Forêt Montmorency of the Université Laval is the world's largest teaching and research forest. Located only 70 km north of Quebec City, it is located in the southernmost portion of Québec's boreal forest. The presence of the Charlevoix caribou herd illustrates the northern character of this region.

During this excursion, the Montmorency Forest will serve as a window into the major conservation and development challenges facing Québec's boreal forest: ecological forest management, multi-use development and tourism, biomass and carbon balance, conservation of water, conservation of biodiversity.

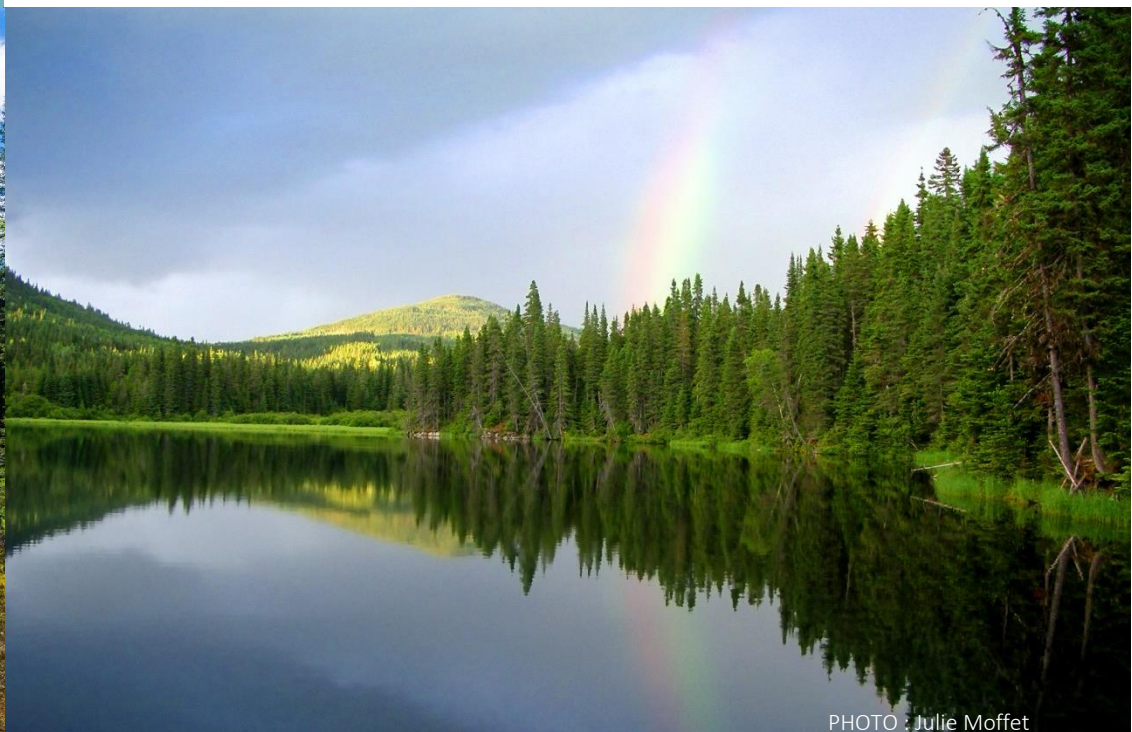
